## General responsibilities

- Handling guest concerns, while making decisions within the guidelines to offer recovery in consultation with the GS Coordinator or Department Head.

- During times of low occupancy, the candidate will also work as the front desk agent.
- Will be the go-to support for the GS team when needed to help with any duties such as check-in process or shuttling for example and will provide the process oversight to all GS functions following the Inn's standard operating procedures.
- Direct, implement and maintain our service and management philosophy which serves as a guide to our team.
